Violin Orchestra Class

an After School Enrichment Program

Students from grades 6th-8th are invited to participate in this twice weekly 45 minute orchestra class. The school year will be split into two sessions (a winter and a spring session). The orchestra will participate in the school concerts and instruments will be available to rent through the school. In order for this to work, we will need a minimum of 12 students to participate.

Creating a successful orchestra will require that students commit to practicing at home in addition to the two classes a week. In order to schedule our time with Mr. Terry, we need to know the interest level by the deadline date.

The fee is \$120 per session, that's less than \$5 /class. Students are welcome to bring their own instruments or rent them from the school for the reduced rate of \$10 per month. Scholarships are available for students needing assistance.

Details:

- This afterschool enrichment program is open to 6th - 8th graders.
- It will take place on campus two days a week right after school (Mondays and Fridays)
- Sessions will be 3:15-4pm.
- There will be a cost of \$120/session.
- Two sessions are being proposed:
 Winter: mid-Sept. to Dec. and Spring: Feb. to May
- The Orchestra will play at the school concerts.
- Students will be able to rent instruments from the school for a nominal fee of \$10/month.
- There is a 12 student minimum to make this work.
